Are qubits "deadbits" for general-purpose quantum computing? Against this main-stream concept, I will describe in details a proper quantum processor (US Patent #8,525,544), anchored in cellular automaton, and its intrinsic wiring concept, the geometry implications and the space-time blocks needed for a true artificial intelligence.
